Supplies:

- [Paper Pizazz® Busy Scrapper's Solution Vintage Papers](#): Striped with white flourish papers (2 sheets) plus alphabet tiles and artwork cut-outs
- [Vintage Embellish-abilities™](#): White big brads, white brads and white sheer ribbon
- white cardstock
- [white pen](#)
- [foam tape](#)
- [glue stick](#)
- clear adhesive tape

Instructions:

For the Left Page:

1. Place one sheet of paper with the stripes running vertically and the white flourish in the bottom left corner. Run a length of white sheer ribbon across the top of the page, wrapping the ends around the edges and taping them to the back. Add a white big brad to each end of the ribbon length, then glue a circular artwork cut-out centered on each brad. Use foam tape to attach alphabet tiles at varying angles across the ribbon length to spell the page title.
2. Mat a horizontal photo on white cardstock and trim the mat to 1/8". Glue the floral ribbon border cut-out across the bottom of the photo, trimming excess even with the edges of the photo mat and reserving for later. Glue the photo over the right side of the page, just under the title.
3. Use a white pen to journal the name, place and date on three tag cut-outs. Use white brads to attach the tags across the right end of the border running along the bottom of the photo.
4. Accent the flourish to the left of the photo with a white brad. Fold two 3" lengths of white sheer ribbon in half. Secure the ribbons over the large circular pattern in

White works particularly well with the white flourish pattern on these vintage papers, and it helps my photos stand out from the colors and patterns printed in the background.

the bottom left corner of the page with a white big brad in the center. Glue a circular artwork cut-out over the big brad.

For the Right Page:

1. Place the other sheet of paper with the stripes running vertically and the white flourish in the top right corner. Mat a vertical photo on white cardstock and trim the mat to 1/8". Add the "happy" word clip to the top right edge of the photo. Fold a 2" length of white sheer ribbon in half and secure the loose ends behind the top of the word clip, then glue the photo in the top left corner of the page.
2. Mat a horizontal photo on white cardstock, trimming the mat to 1/8". Recall the excess floral ribbon border cut-out from the left page and glue it down the right edge of the photo, trimming any excess even with the edges of the photo mat. Add the "enjoy" word clip to the top left corner of the photo and accent the top of the clip with a folded piece of sheer ribbon, as in step 1. Glue the photo in the bottom left corner of the page and add the "marvelous" cut-out over the bottom right corner with foam tape.
3. Use foam tape to secure number tiles in the bottom right corner of the page to represent the year. Accent the small circular patterns printed on the background paper with a white brad in the center. Fold two 3" lengths of white sheer ribbon in half. Secure the ribbons over the large circular pattern over the right side of the page with a white big brad in the center. Glue a circular artwork cut-out over the big brad.
